I'm Ready to Join: What Do I Do Now?

- 1. Have you read the Information for Prospective Members?** If your answer is no, STOP and go to the FRPC website and read this information before proceeding. www.fourrivers.ponyclub.org
- 2. Have you attended at least one FRPC mounted or unmounted meeting or an FRPC Horsemanship Camp and met current members and leaders and observed what goes on at a meeting?** If the answer is no, STOP and be sure to complete this step before proceeding.
- 3. Have you visited the Four Rivers Pony Club website and read the general information and downloaded the current Fee Structure and made sure you understand the fees that are involved in initially joining?** If the answer is no, STOP and be sure to do this before proceeding. Be sure to read the information on the Four Rivers website also and become familiar with where to find forms and meeting schedule information.
- 4. Have you visited the national USPC website at www.ponyclub.org and read the general information on that site?** Please read the general information on the home page and the link to the Pony Club pledge. Feel free to peruse the site and become familiar with where to find forms and visit the bookstore.
- 5. Congratulations! Now you are ready to complete the final steps. If you have not attended two meetings, or one horsemanship camp plus a meeting, you can schedule your second observation now and arrange to do your orientation to club membership and policies at that visit. You can also schedule your orientation for a time separate from a club meeting.**
